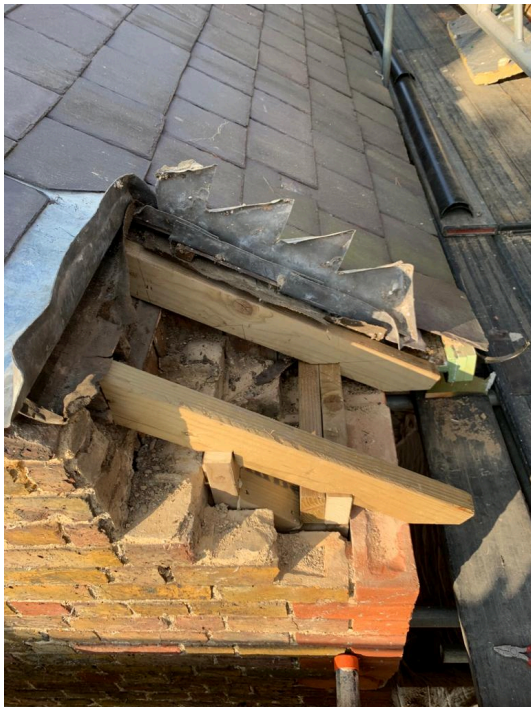
A BLINDING ADDITION
