GR6 UPDATE



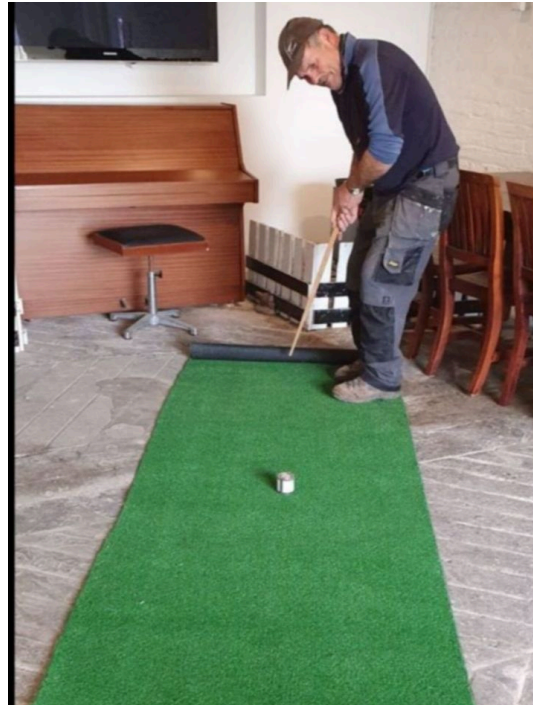
