REVISED OPENING HOURS



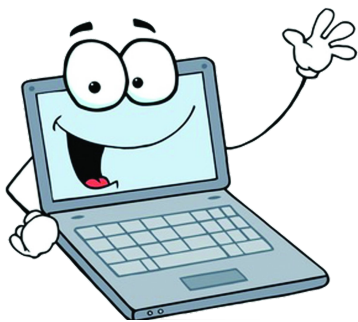
New opening hours with even more time for you to enjoy your favourite pub.

MINI-MARKET SUCCESS



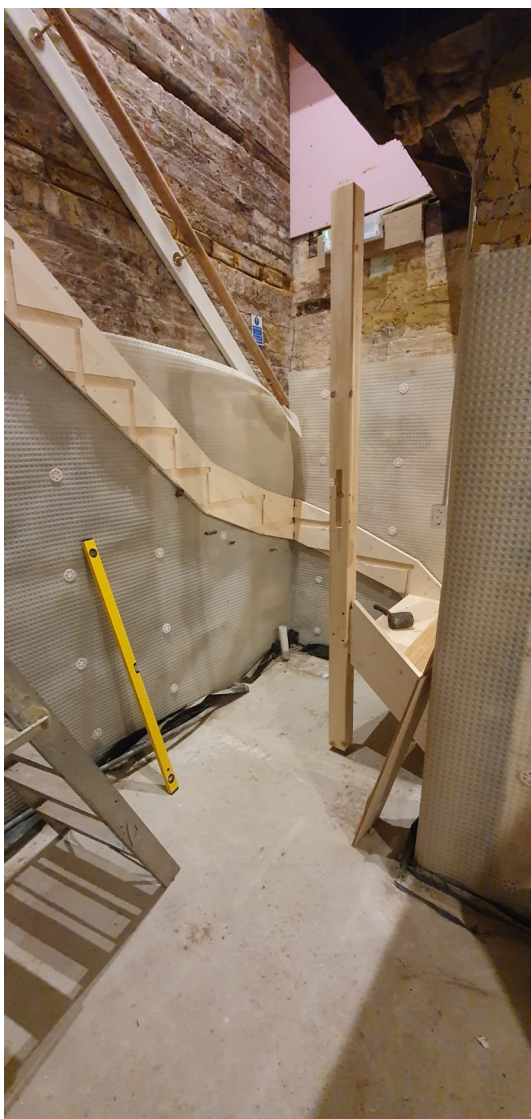

FOOD VAN DEPARTS

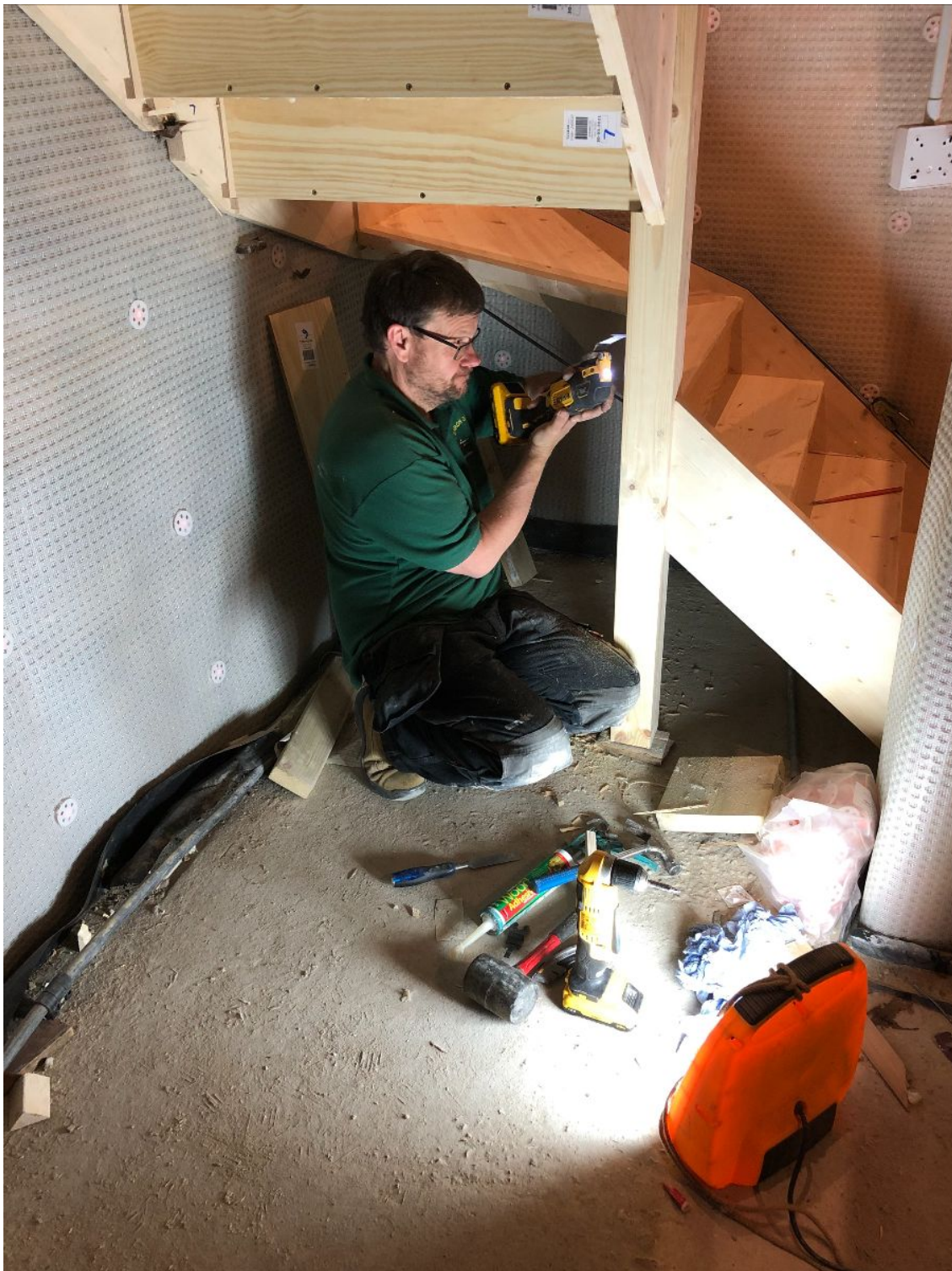
