GR6 UPDATE

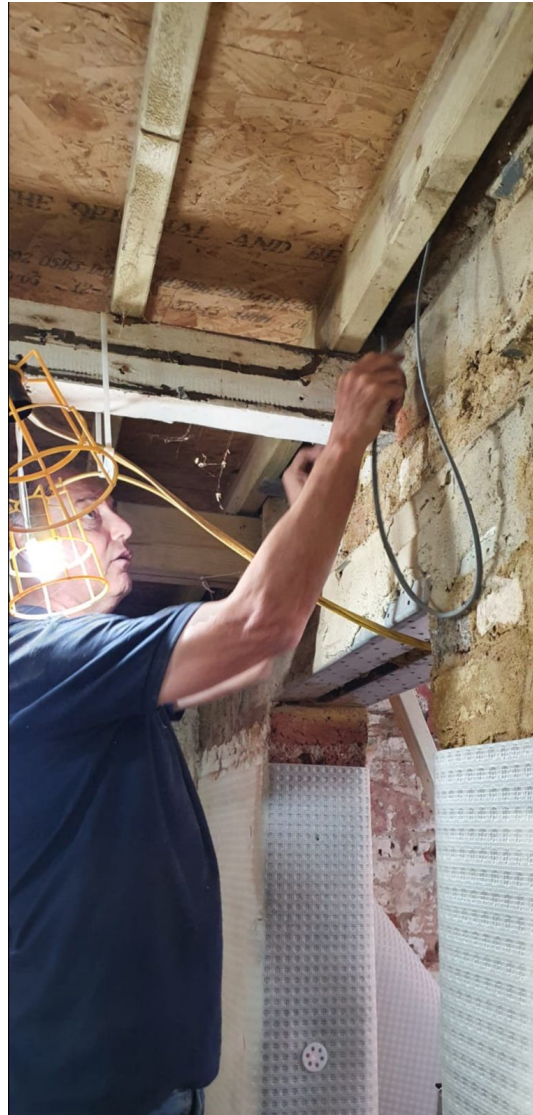
