WEDNESDAY CREATIVE DRAWING



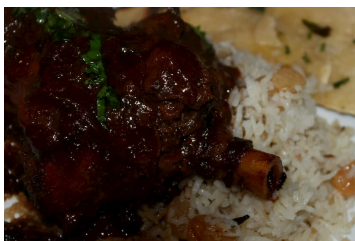
