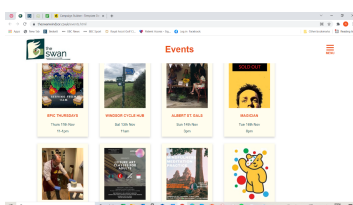
QUIZ WINNERS

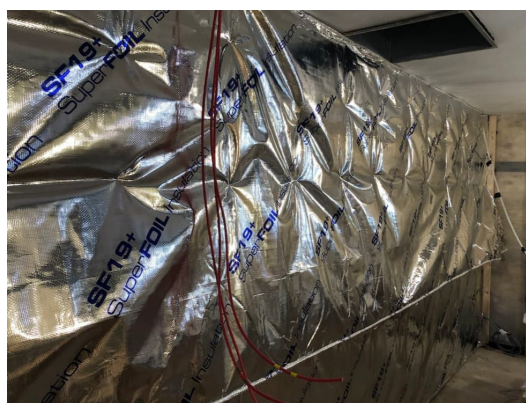
