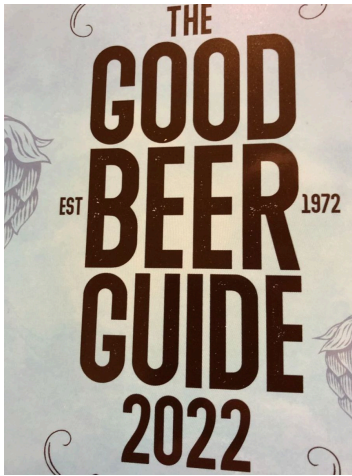
CHILDREN IN NEED SUCCESS

SUNDAY CLOTHES SWAP



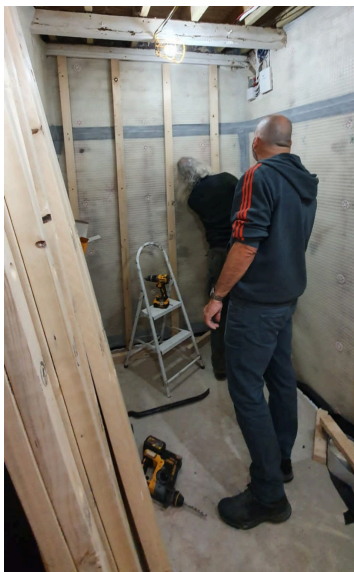
