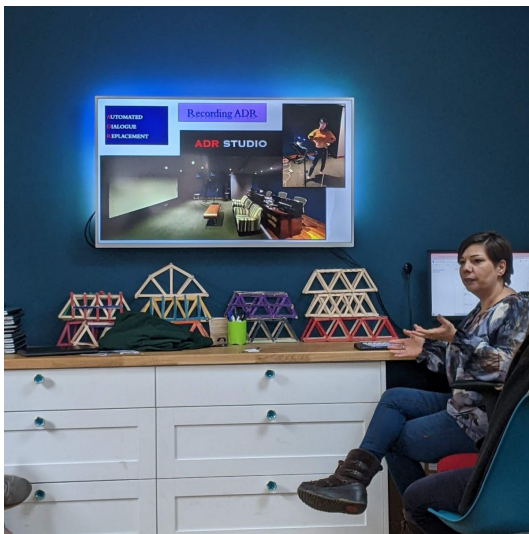
STAMMTISCH
