SATURDAY CYCLE HUB



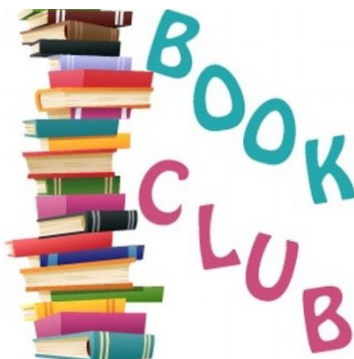

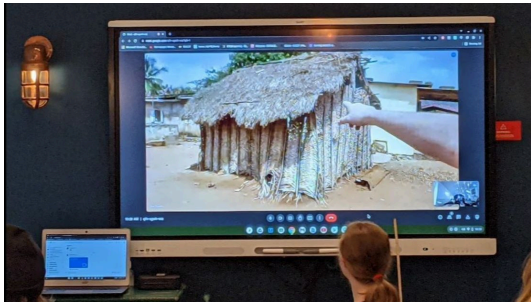
6 Nations Rugby is back and all games will be shown live at The Swan on 26 & 27 Feb:

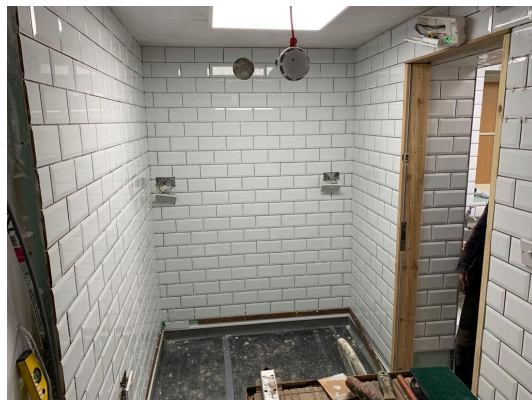
homelessness and how the community are striving for solutions.
