TUESDAY HOME INSTEAD



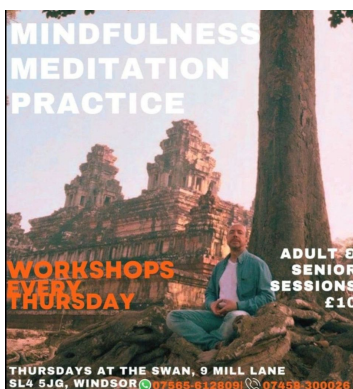

EPIC THURSDAY



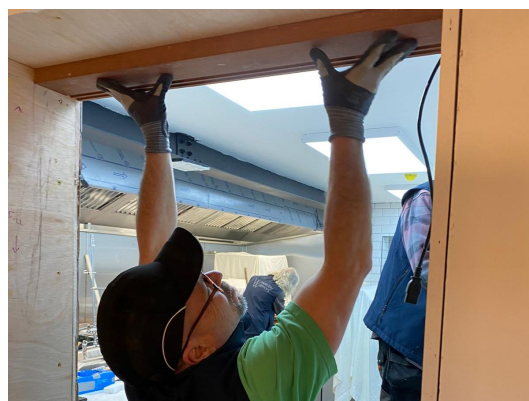
