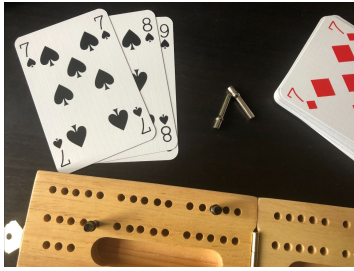

COMIC RELIEF COFFEE MORNING



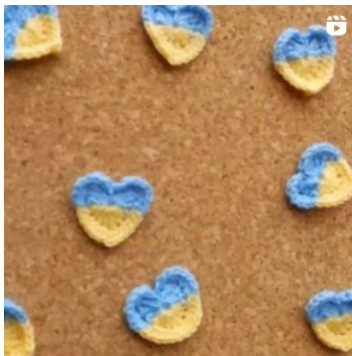
