SATURDAY CYCLE HUB



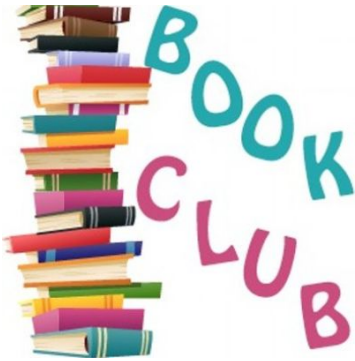

GR6 UPDATE



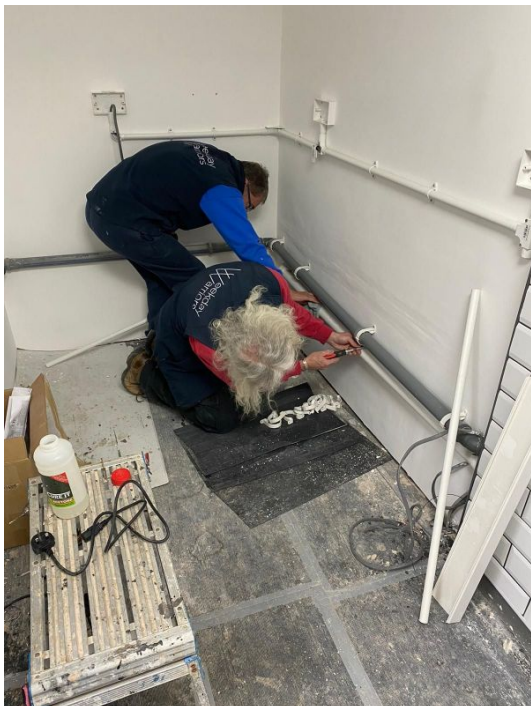
