QUIZ WINNERS



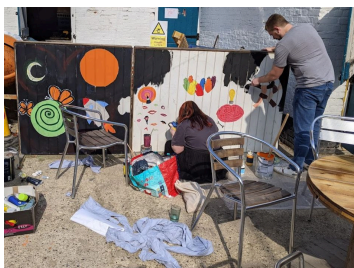
