



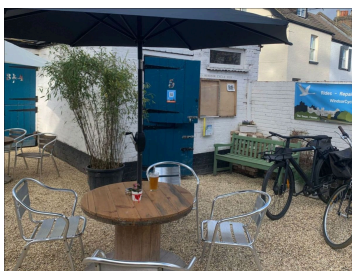
TWO WHEELS OR FOUR LEGS! BOTH ON OFFER AT THE SWAN

SATURDAY CYCLE HUB



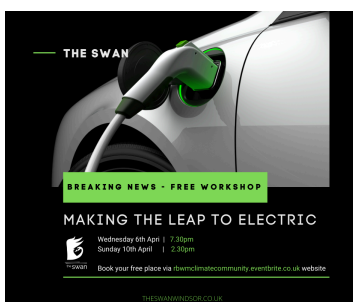
