ART CLASSES AT THE SWAN



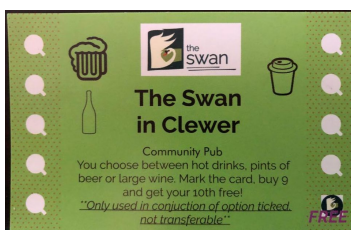
