DUBLICIOUS



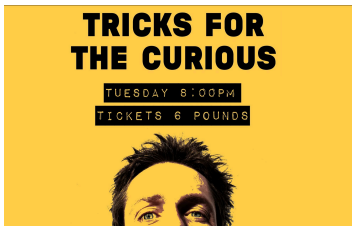
