We even had our very own Royal visitor as Bess made, and proudly wore, her very own crown.





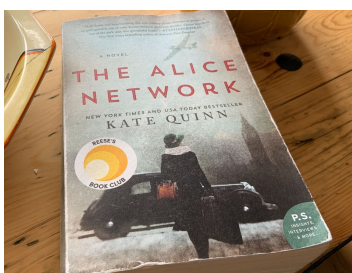
