BBQ SUNDAY



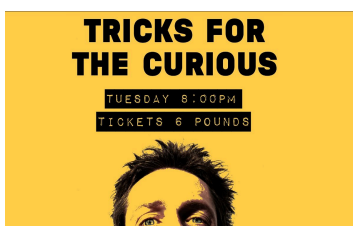
