CHEESE AND WINE



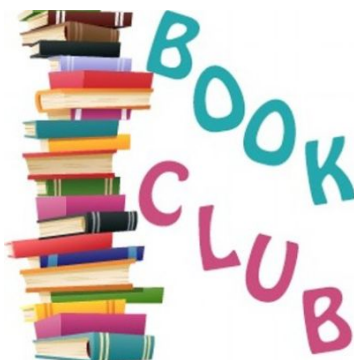
