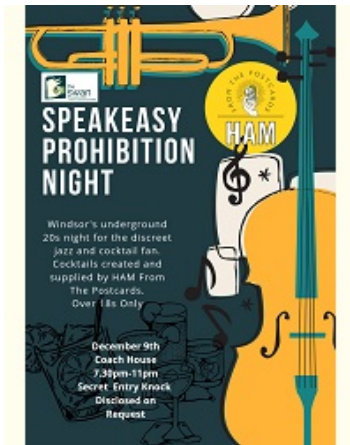
The Festive Season is well and truly underway at The Swan with something for everyone. Read on for details of just some of the events or take a look [here](#) for the full programme for the month.

SWAN FESTIVE MENU



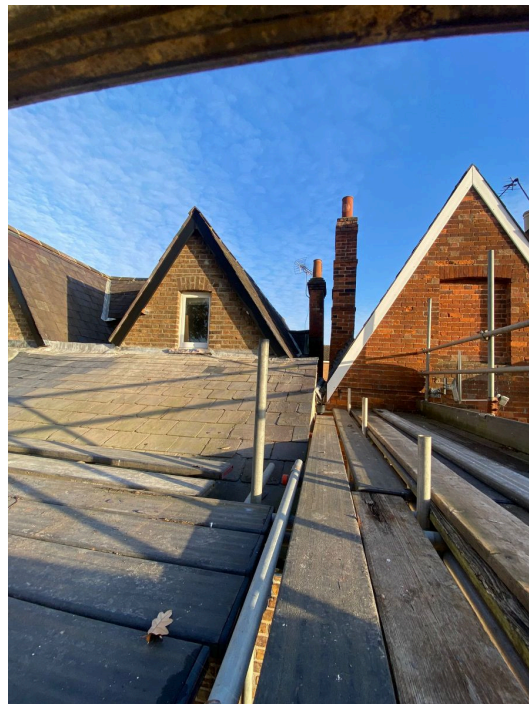
