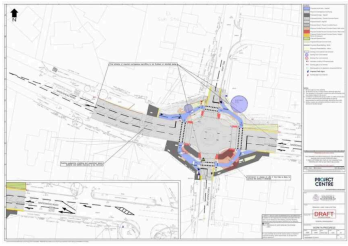
QUIZ WINNERS

PUBLIC CONSULTATIONS



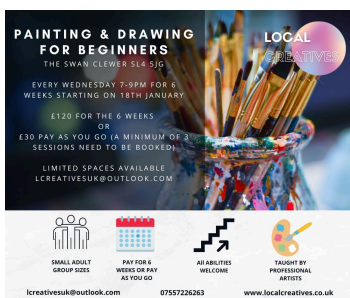
