STAY & PLAY



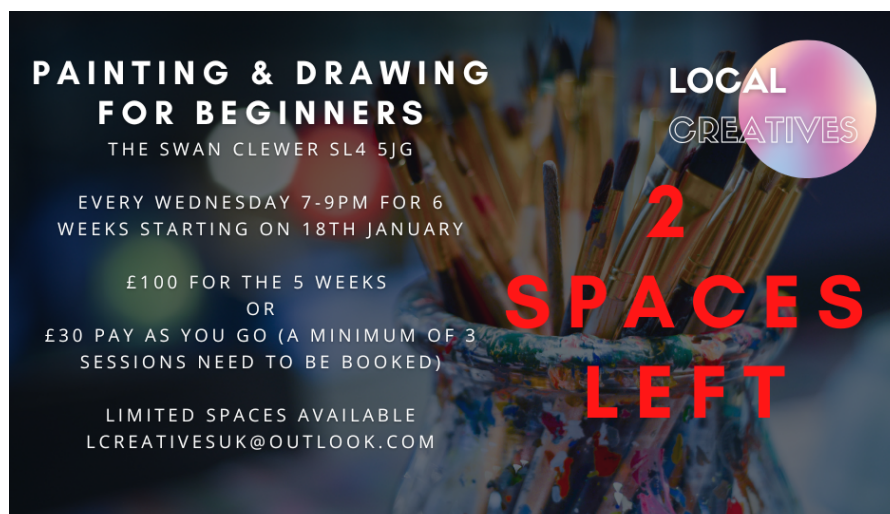
