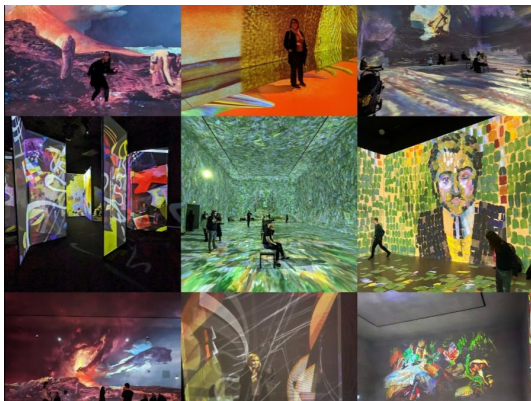
BINGO WINNERS
