CHATTY CAFE



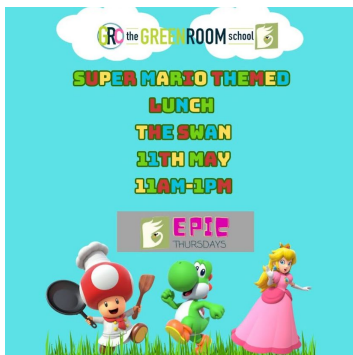
