RUGBY WORLD CUP



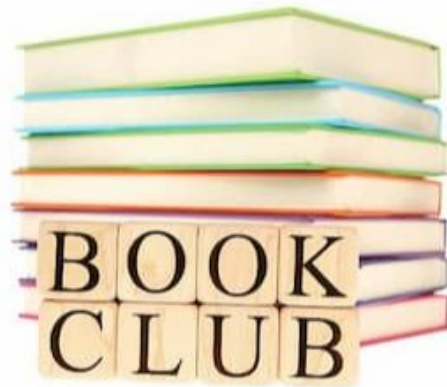
