THIS WEEK'S QUIZ NIGHT

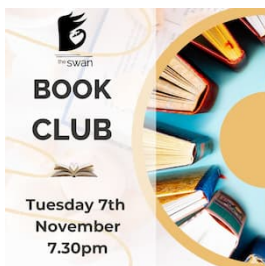
