MICKY'S SUNDAY KITCHEN TAKEOVER



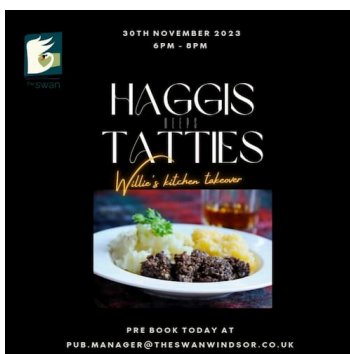
