New Years Day 1 Jan: 12noon-8pm

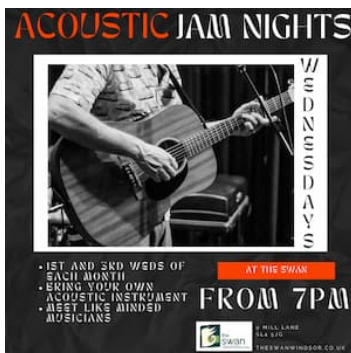
2 Jan onwards: Normal hours
