OUR REGULAR CLUBS

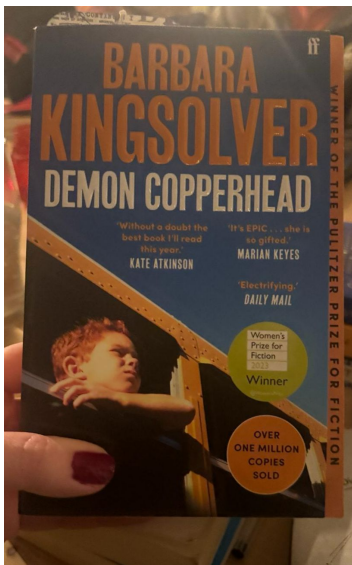
