SWAN MINI-MARKET



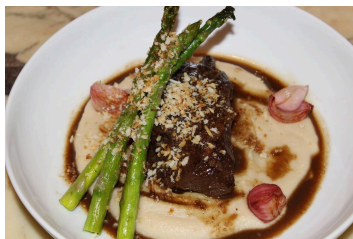
