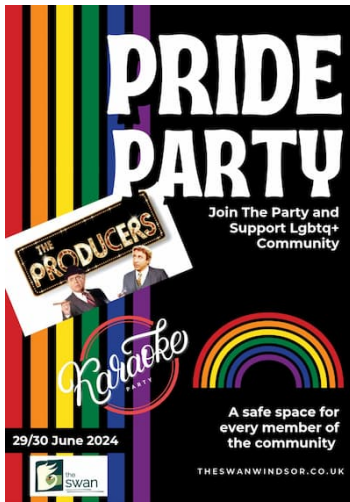
The sun has finally arrived and here at The Swan we are gearing up our programme of summer events to help you enjoy your award-nominated Community Pub to the full!
