Most of our community clubs and events are free; all are open to everyone and very much welcome new people to join them – see more details on our website by clicking below.

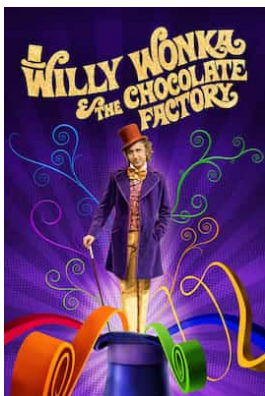
