Sat 31st: The Stitch Gang, having a natter while they knit and sew in the bar, 1pm-3pm.

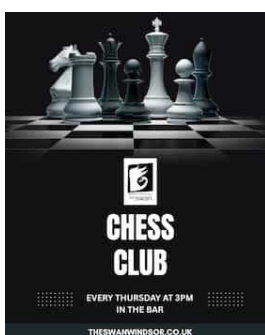
Note: There is **NO organised Dog Walk** tomorrow, but feel free to meet and do your own thing if you wish!

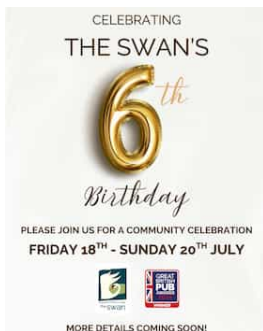
COMING SOON!
