Fridays: 12noon – 11pm

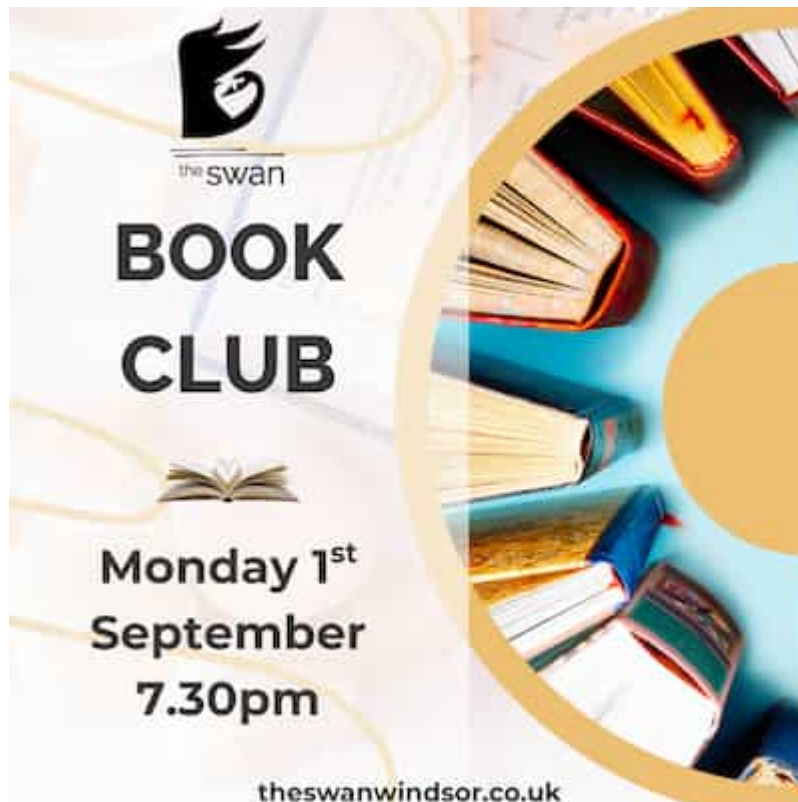
Saturdays: 11am – 11pm
