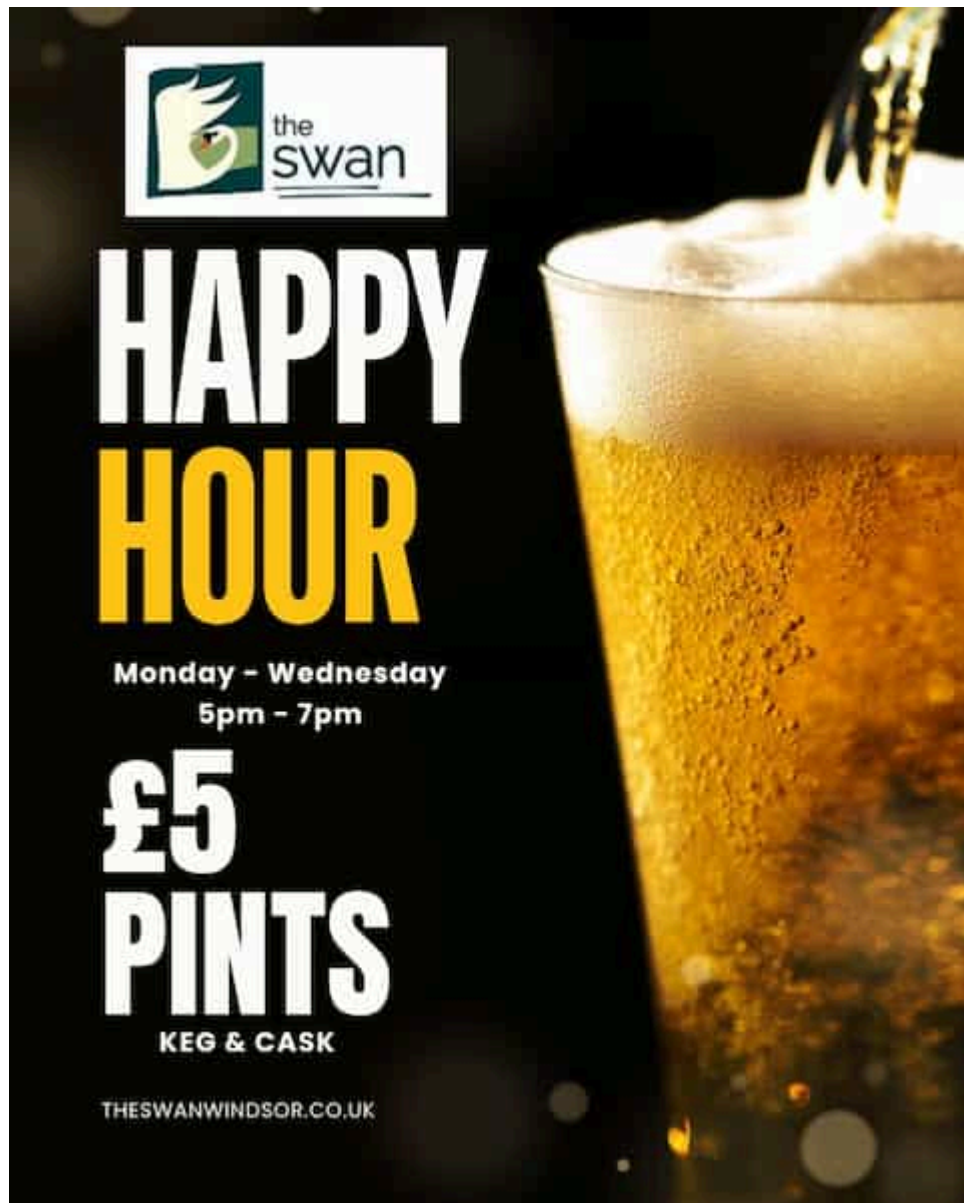
Hi Friend,

WHAT'S ON AT THE SWAN

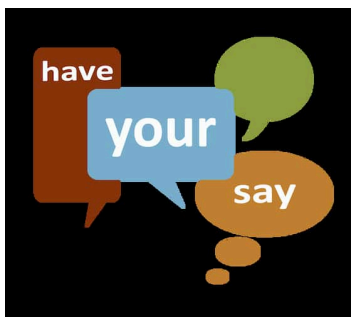
