



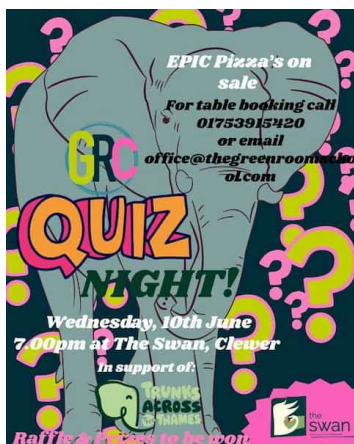

Most of our community clubs and events are free, open to everyone and are friendly groups who very much welcome new people to join them – see more details on our website.

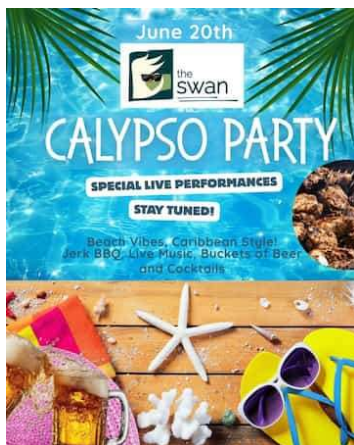
COMING SOON!
